This insidious infiltration of anti-Torah agendas in our Holy Land has been happening for years, and the worst targets are the children. Winning the power to set the WZO agenda and preside over its vast budget is a pure numbers game.

Every American Jew is eligible to vote in this election, which will choose the 152 American delegates to the WZO. Whichever slate gets more votes will receive more delegates, and more influence.

To this end, Rabbi Pesach Lerner established the Eretz HaKodesh slate, putting forth delegates running on a platform of Torah values.
